- Fees & Fines

- Lack of government support
- No reliable data
- Unwillingness in private sector to support entrepreneurs
- Limited mentoring facilities

- Inability to obtain labour qouta
- Issues with illegal workers

- Sophisticated framework for businesses
- Difficult to access services from Government Institutions
- Gaps in existing framework to nurture SMEs
- Costly requirements





# **SME Development Strategy**

### **Access to Finance**

- Products: SME Development Finance Corporation
- Mentoring & other support: Business Center Corporation

2

# **Assistance for Tax Compliance**

- Assistance to prepare Financial Statements and Tax Returns
- Remove requirement to file nil returns
- Refund mechanisms for excess tax payments

Remove barriers to startups
Streamline Registrations, Permits, Licenses,
Approvals & Authorizations

• Increase service accessibility through Business Centers and island councils





## **Improving Government's Service Delivery**

- Online Services (Business Registration)
- Repealing issuance of unnecessary permits & licenses
- National Single Window Project (MED, MIRA, Customs & other key stakeholders)
- Strengthening customer support



### **Prioritize SMEs in Government Procurement Processes**

 Advocate for a more favorable criteria for SMEs to compete in government procurement processes



# **Duty Exemptions for SMEs**

 Provide duty exemption for SMEs enabling them to grow their business



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# **Dealing with illegal businesses**

- Illegal businesses engaging general trade
- Foreign workers' control over the supply chain for locally produced horticulture crops
- Illegal businesses engaging in preparing meals & delivery for expatriate workers



## **Legal Reform Package (Short term)**

Amendments to key legislations affecting SMEs:

- Business Registration Act
- Companies Act
- Law on Sale of Imported Goods
- Law on Café, Restaurant, Cafeteria & Canteens
- Revenue Stamp Act
- Competition Bill & Consumer Protection Act

 Provide government support to NGOs promoting various business sectors & industries





# Address Sector/Industry specific issues

### **Guest Houses**

- Modernize the regulatory framework
- Provide government incentives

### **Construction Sector**

• Local Construction Companies first policy

### **F&B Sector**

- Review the existing permits/licenses and authorization processes to create a more enabling environment through MFDA/Customs
- Incentives to produce locally

### **ICT Sector**

- Enhance the legal framework
- Provide government support to introduce an efficient payment system/solutions
- Access to finance

### **Education Sector**

Promoting and supporting private sector education service
 providers – to operate as a business
